A language reviewer revises English, but authors are strongly urged to have the papers reviewed linguistically prior to submission. Manuscripts submitted must be edited, for clarity and conformity purposes according to [Authors guidelines](#), and must not have been previously published or simultaneously submitted elsewhere. The papers can be submitted online by the corresponding author (or the person who takes responsibility for the integrity of the work as a whole, from submission to the published article). The submission process is described on the web site. An [Author Statement](#), available on the website, should be enclosed by corresponding author declaring that the paper has not been published anywhere else, permission to reproduce the material, authorship credit, contributors and creditors for the integrity of the work as a whole, to avoid the conflicts of interest and scientist fraud, and respecting the ethical principles of publishing, research and scientific rights.
